One of the most famous composers and lyricists of the 1920s/30s, native Hoosier Cole Porter helped to create what we now call the Great American Songbook. His decades-long string of Broadway successes introduced songs that were musically complex with witty, urbane lyrics that audiences loved. Songs such as "You Do Something to Me," "Love for Sale," "Night and Day," "Anything Goes," "In the Still of the Night," "Begin the Beguine," "You'd Be So Nice to Come Home To," and "I Get a Kick Out of You" remain popular standards today and have been recorded by well-known artists from around the globe. Brief Context: "I Get a Kick Out of You" composed by Cole Porter, made it's debut in 1934 as part of the Broadway musical Anything Goes, preceding it's appearance in the 1936 film adaptation. Initially performed by Ethel Merman, the song has been interpreted by numerous renowned artists such as Frank Sinatra, Dolly Parton, and Ella Fitzgerald. It has received multiple GRAMMY Award nominations, clinching the 1996 GRAMMY for Best Instrumental Arrangement with Accompanying Vocals by Mel Tormé.




